**WHY SHOULD I REGISTER EARLY?**

Due to facility regulations, the 2010 campout will hold a maximum of 1,000 registered campers. We recommend that each camper register early to help ensure your spot. The first 600 pre-registered campers' applications received will be guaranteed entrance to the campout. Campsites will be assigned according to postmark date only. The remaining 400 registered campers will be allowed entrance on a first-come, first-serve basis on site after opening the campout at 8:00 am on June 18, 2010.

Campout registrations: \$20.00 per registered camper (this includes adults and children, 8 and older).  
 Day Passes: \$10.00 per person on Saturday only.  
 Children under 7 are free.

 ABSOLUTELY, NO REFUNDS WILL BE GIVEN AFTER JUNE 1, 2010.

The Rollins lake Reservoir has 800 acres of water and 26 miles of shoreline. It is stocked regularly with fish. Orchard Springs Resort also has four multi-use restrooms with pay showers, a stage, volleyball area and large meadow for camping when all numbered campsites have been assigned.

Shuttles will be provided to relieve the burden of increased traffic as well as limited overflow parking for additional vehicles. **You will be asked to cooperate by using the shuttles instead of your vehicles. Vehicles are not allowed on dirt roads, except to specific camper and motor home sites.** Traffic will be stopped at the top of the hill unless you have a campsite down the hill or a boat to launch at the docks.

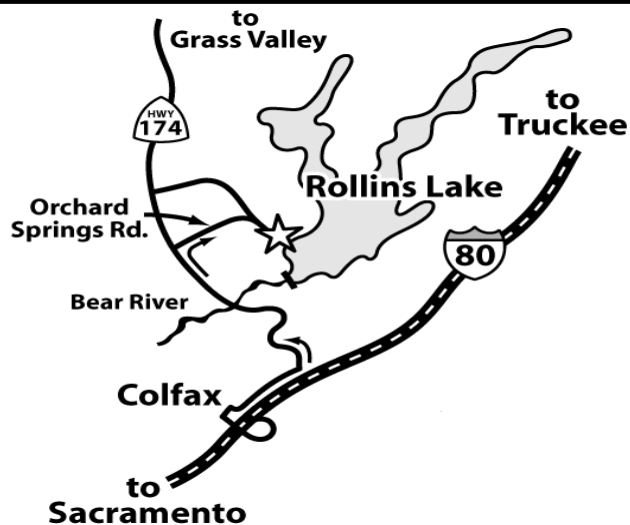
